Course Load	Maximum 21 Credit Hours each semester (7 to 8 courses)
Credit and Grading System	1 native "Credit Hour" equals 1.5 ECTS (Some universities use conversion factor 2). The minimum passing grade for each course is 50%. Fees	Total of 255 JOD (Incoming Students do not pay any tuition fees): • <u>Application Fees</u>: 25 JOD (Not applicable for Erasmus+ students) • <u>Registration Fees/per semester</u>: 120 JOD (Not applicable for Erasmus+ students) • <u>Computer Fees/per semester</u>: 60 JOD (Not applicable for Erasmus+ students) • <u>Health Insurance Fees/per semester</u>: 50 JOD
Health Insurance	In addition to the obligatory GJU Health Insurance, we recommend our Incoming Students to get a Travel Health Insurance from their own country. Personal Liability Insurance is not required.
Visa for 6 Months	A one-month visa can be purchased on arrival at the airport in Amman for 40 JOD. Later on, it must be extended twice (6 months in total).
Visa for more than 6 Months	For a second semester at GJU: The International Office will help with getting the Residence Permit from the Jordanian Ministry of Interior. For an Internship: The company is responsible for providing a Residence Permit for the period of the internship.

Accommodation	There are no student housing/dorms available, but the International Office assists in finding accommodation for Incoming Students.
